The courses required by BFTS during the first year of employment are as follows:

Initial Training Requirement for Child Care Centers:

- Four (4) clock hours in disease control, cleanliness, basic hygiene, illness detection/disposition, childhood injury control
- Two (2) clock hours in identifying, reporting, and meeting the needs of abused, neglected, or deprived children
- The remaining four (4) clock hours can be in job-related (task-focused) topics.

Fire Safety Requirement

A minimum of five (5) hours initial fire safety training is required for all staff members within ninety (90) days of employment, receipt of license, being commissioned, or the opening of a new center or home. A minimum of two (2) hours fire safety refresher training is required of all staff every three (3) years.

Initial Training Requirement for Family Child Care Providers:

20 Hours of Pre-service Required, which consist of:

- Orientation for application and rules— Registration Orientation Meeting (ROM) 6 hours credit
- CPR/First Aid—Infant/Child/Adult CPR/First Aid 4 hour credit

10 hours (2 hours each in the following topics) of training in the following areas each year:

- Early Learning Standards
- Communication
- Professional and Leadership Development
- Business Management
- Advocacy for parent, children and staff

Here are some quick reminders:

- Pre-registration check-in and On-Site registration is from **7:00am - 8:00 am**
- First session starts at **8:00 am**
- Sessions bring **promptly** at their designated times. Entrance into the session **15 minutes after** the session has begun **is not allowed**. This is a state rule that all presenters agree to abide by.
